The transformation of Cirque Du Soleil and Celine Dion dancer to performer generated theater artist is mirrored in this dark, comic and at times grotesque fable about our modern day obsession with self- image. The exquisite movement skills of Lafond juxtaposed with the world of distortion and manipulation accentuates LITTLE LADY's tormented and blissful metamorphosis.

LITTLE LADY is a one-woman show, a comedy inspired by years of living in Las Vegas with the glamorous fake life and the beautiful emptiness of the desert. Confined in a scientific laboratory where the audience members are the doctors, Little Lady undergoes plastic surgery, gets addicted to medication, becomes a Pavlov's dog, and learns through TV programs what our society is all about. Physical theater, dance, clown, jester, contortion and mime are mixed together to offer a moment of great humanity.

Since 2012 the show has been performed in the United States and Canada. It was awarded the "Favorite Festival Award" at the Frigid Festival in New York and the "Most Daring Show Award" at the Fringe Festival in London, Ont. It got raving reviews, amazing feed back, sold out shows and was "Held over" in NY and "Best of Fest" in Ottawa.
